Finally, after years of organizing camps for the kids, we're embarking on the first Art Adventures for ADULTS! So to all the parents who have asked us in the past, when and if there will be one for the grown-ups, well here it is. Join us. This will truly be the adventure—to make and experience art in a university studio setting, to learn the fundamentals necessary to create original artwork.

Lasting one week (July 6–10, 2009), the program meets daily from 6:30 to 9:30pm at the TCU Moudy Building. Participants will concentrate on their choice of studio art: Ceramics, Altered Media, Drawing, or Watercolor.

Studio classes will be held in the North Moudy Bldg on the TCU campus. Located on the corner of Canty & University Dr.

Ceramics

This class will offer basic hand-building and wheel techniques. Kim Lovelace will teach you how to make functional and fun projects such as whistles, slump molds, and a hand thrown bowl.

Altered Media

This class will offer participants the experience to let their creativity flow through the use of altered techniques. Come learn hands-on techniques with Kellye Vandergriff. Choose what you would like to alter—such as books, memory boxes, unfinished paper Mache forms, or even various objects to make jewelry. Leave with ideas, resources, and artwork to inspire future projects.

Drawing

If you think you can only draw “stick figures” then this is the class for you. Students will work on basic techniques and skills to improve their drawing ability. Various techniques will be explored in a fun and inviting environment led by Janet Chaffee.

Watercolor

Come have fun while you improve your painting skills whether you are a beginner or an experienced artist. Use exciting watercolor techniques with your own subjects. Danny Jones uses individual instruction which allows students to grow at their own pace. You will be amazed at the result in this confidence-building watercolor workshop.
